Any qualified skier can participate in this event for ratings & nationals qualifications with or without EVP approval. EVP approval is required for inclusion in the placements.

### E/L/R

All events will be run class E. For events run class L & R at the 2012 Nationals, skiers will have the option to ski class L&R at the regionals. All such requests must be made in writing to the registrar or scorer on the day prior to the event to allow for proper officials assignments. All attempts to break a record must be made known to the chief judge at least 1 hour prior to the event

### OTHER SKIER QUALIFICATIONS

In Addition to the standard NRL qualification methods, the Eastern Region Council has approved qualifications based upon the final 2012 ski year National Rankings List (NLR) so that you may be better able to plan your summer travel plans.

Set a goal and ski this number in 2012 ski year once and you're qualified!

#### A few points to pay attention to:

- ✓ Top 3 skiers in each event/division of state tournaments also qualify
- ✓ Scores of ZERO, even if a placement is awarded, will not qualify
- ✓ The above depends on skier event volume. If there are only 3 skiers in an event, top 2 qualify
- ✓ Remember...Top 5 in any division/event at Regionals qualifies you for Nationals!!

### PRACTICE INFORMATION

We will make every attempt to make practice available to anyone who wants to ski. Purchase practice tickets at the registration tent or online. Practice will start Monday morning and will be on a first come first serve basis.

Cost: \$25 for 4 Slalom passes or 4 trick passes or 2 jumps. Or 5 tickets for \$100.
